MPF investors enjoyed strong return in 2017

Hong Kong's MPF investors with equity exposure enjoyed strong returns in 2017. According to independent research provider MPF Ratings, the MPFR Index of Equity Fund (Hong Kong & China) which gauges the performance of 82 registered HK & China equity MPF fund scheme, has risen by 35.95% from January to November, outperforming the Hang Seng Index's 32.62% gain, and making it the best performing asset class during the period. Meanwhile, the MPFR Index of Equity Fund (Asia) which track the performance of 40 Asian equity MPF also recorded a remarkable performance of 32.36% over the same period.

BCT members who invested into "BCT (Pro) China & HK Equity Fund" and "BCT (Pro) Asian Equity Fund" have also benefited from the strong performances. As of 30 November 2017, the funds have climbed 40.48% and 35.97% respectively.

From 1 January 2018, MPF intermediaries are required to pay registration fees, approval fees, and an annual fee. Make sure you pay on time as an additional fee of an amount equal to 10% of the annual fee will be payable if the annual fee is not paid in full on or before deadline.
